FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

1. Do I need a negative Covid-19 Test or to be vaccinated to attend The Country Fest?

You do not need to show proof of vaccination or a negative Covid-19 Test to attend our event. Guests should evaluate their risk in determining whether to attend. By entering the grounds of your own free will, you assume the risk.

2. Do I have to wear a mask and social distance?

Masks won't be required at this event, it will be consumers' choice as to what makes them comfortable. There will be plenty of area to space out and social distancing is recommended to continue to curb the spread of COVID-19.

3. What is TCF 2?

4. What does non-transferrable mean?

Non-transferable means the same person must use the ticket all 3 or 4 days of the festival. 3-Day Commuter tickets and 3-Day Festival Camping tickets cannot be broken into individual days and used by multiple people.

5. What if I am camping on the same site as my friends but cannot arrive with them?

As long as the site does not exceed the 3 item rule, you can join them at a later time. There will be a designated area by the Festival Camping Gate for overflow cars if there is not room for them on your campsite. Even if you are joining friends, you must get your ticket scanned in at the Festival Camping Gate to receive your wristband.

GOOD TO KNOW:

1. If you want to upgrade your commuter ticket to camping you can call into our office M-F 9am-5pm (330-930-0398) to upgrade them.

2. Commuters will not be allowed in the Festival Campgrounds after 6:30pm. They have access to the Waterpark and amenities of the Festival Campgrounds 10am-6:30pm.

3. Our festival merchandise (festival t-shirt, hats, clothing) will be available in the tent near all of the food vendors.

4. You can leave your car in the commuter parking lot overnight but if it is left there after 9:30am the following day, you will be charged the daily parking rate. You may **NOT** sleep/camp in your car in the Commuter Parking Lot.
