The Year 6 bun sale raised £101.01, closely followed by the Year 5 bun sale, which raised £92. Both of these amounts go directly to the respective year group for the children to spend during this academic year.

In November, we ran the very first Table Top Sale in the school hall. Along with Matched Funding the event raised a fantastic £472.60 - well done to everyone involved, we are sure this will be the first of many such events.

The Christmas Card sales were once again really popular this year and generated a substantial profit for the school.

Thanks to everyone who supported the event, either by donating gifts, crackers, cakes, toys, or by your child taking part in non-uniform day, by you and your family volunteering before, during or after the fair or in so many other ways. We raised £1400 on the day and are hopeful this figure will increase with successful Matched Funding.
