PE & Sport at St.Chad's CE Primary School

At St.Chad's C.E. Primary School, we recognise and value the importance of PE and the impact high quality PE has on our pupil's health and wellbeing. To achieve this we have been given Sports Premium funding provided by the Government.

What is the Sports Premium funding?

The government is providing funding of £150 million per annum to provide new and substantial primary school sport funding. The funding is being jointly provided by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport, and will see money going directly to primary school Headteachers to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all their children. Each school will receive £8,000 plus an extra £5 per pupil equates to nearly £9,000 a year. The money can only be spent on sport and PE provision in schools.

Management of PE

The Academy's strategy in relation to PE funding is coordinated by the Head of School and PE subject leader. Needs are analysed, issues are identified and priorities set. The PE team meets termly to:

- Review all pupil activities
- Review the strategies that are employed to deliver these activities
- Ensure resources are targeted appropriately and in a timely fashion.
- To recommend additional strategies to support targeted pupils or groups in particular those pupils and families that find it hard to access physical activities outside of school
- In addition we review those pupils that are performing at a higher level than their peers in order that we can support their further development

St.Chad's C.E. Primary School Sport Funding 2016-2017

The government is providing funding of £150 million per annum to improve the provision of physical education and sport within primary schools. St.Chad's CE Primary School received £8,890 based on the number of pupils on roll.
