**Re: Nell Bank, Ilkley - Year 4 Residential 2019**

Firstly, thank you all for attending the Nell Bank information meeting. Hopefully the children are excited and looking forward to our forthcoming residential visit to Nell Bank, Ilkley on the **4-6<sup>th</sup> of March**. This letter further outlines the key details of the trip, including travel arrangements, sleeping arrangements and groupings, kit requirements, medical needs and payment details.

**Travel Arrangements:** We will depart from St Chad's Primary School at 11:15am on Monday 4<sup>th</sup> March; arriving at Nell Bank around 12:00pm. We will then return to school on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> March. Children can then be collected from school at the normal time of 3:10pm. On the morning on the 4<sup>th</sup> March, children can arrive at the normal time with their day sack and overnight bag.

**Sleeping Arrangements:** We will be together, as a group, for the majority of the visit. However, before the trip, children will be given the chance to choose who they would like to share a room with.

**Kit List:** See attached list.

**Medical:** You will find a medical form attached to this letter. We ask that parents/carers fill in the form with any medical requirements for the three days. During our visit, Mrs Futers will attend to all specific medical needs.

**Payment:** The cost of the trip is £70. This will include travel, accommodation, food and activities. The full payment will be set up on ParentPay. You will be able to make small payments against the total amount as is convenient for you, however the full balance must be paid by Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> February 2019.

This will be an excellent three days for the children. Providing them with a chance to learn, laugh and have lots of fun in a different, but accessible and stimulating environment. Pupils will gain valuable life experience and some great memories to take forwards.

## **Kit List - Nell Bank, Ilkley - Year 4 Residential 2019**

### **Day Bag / Rucksack**

- Lunch
- Water bottle (with water in it!)
- Trainers/walking boots
- Coat/Waterproof
  
- Hat
- Gloves
- Sun cream
- Wellies (if you have some)
  
- Medication with associated paperwork – handed in to group leader

**Notes:** If the weather is nice, children may bring £2 for an ice cream on the Moors Walk which will be handed in to their group leader on the morning of the trip. However, there is no shop at Nell Bank; therefore this is the only money which should be brought on the visit.

Scarves, gloves, sun-cream and wellies are weather-dependent. Nell Bank also has wellies and waterproof jackets which children can use if needed on the day. Therefore, please don't feel you have to buy anything specifically for this trip.
