Re: Trip to Eden Camp – Tuesday 2nd October 2018



To support our topic work on World War II this half term, we have arranged to visit Eden Camp in Malton, North Yorkshire. Eden Camp Museum is housed in the buildings and grounds of an original WWII Prisoner of War Camp and offers a broad insight into all aspects of the social and military history of WWII, as well as WWI and post WWII conflicts. Whilst at Eden Camp we will experience the sights, sounds and smells of life on the 'home front' and the 'front line'. Children will also watch a puppet show and sing-a-long with the songs of the 1940's. Pupils will also get to attempt to conquer the junior assault course complete with towers, escape tunnels and other obstacles (weather permitting).

The visit will take place on **Tuesday 2nd October 2018** and we will be travelling to the venue by coach. The coach will leave school at 8:30am. Please ensure your child arrives at school no later than 8:20am on this day. **We will be leaving Malton at approximately 2:15pm and aim to be back at school at approximately 3:45pm.** The cost of this trip is **£12.00** per child. Children will need a packed lunch/bottle of water (no glass bottles or fizzy/energy drinks please). Pupils need to wear their school uniform as normal please.
