Dear Parents/Carers

I hope that you and your children are coping okay with our July bubble closure. Lots of work has been sent via SeeSaw with Teams meetings organised for every day this week. I wanted to send you all a letter with some updates regarding the end of year activities. There have been, as you will know, a lot of changes so please read the following carefully. Safe to say, there is a LOT going on.

Monday 12th July – Production Recording. This is the date the children return to school and incidentally, the date we record our production! This cannot be pushed back any more, much to my horror, so it is essential the children have everything they need (costumes, props) in school this Monday. They have all been told exactly what they need. **If you are having any issues, please do not hesitate to contact me before Monday 13th** so we can work a solution; this is a lot easier than having a child present me with a problem in school on Monday. They have missed so much rehearsal time but I am not one to just cancel something – it might just require a little imagination when viewing!

Tuesday 13th July – Town Hall Organ Workshop. This trip is free for the children and is taking place within COVID safe regulations at Leeds Town Hall. All the children will need is **a mask and a packed lunch**. If your child normally has school dinners, please let me know by Monday 13th if you would like them to have a school packed lunch as this can be organised.

Wednesday 14th July – Meanwood Park Trip. We are headed to Meanwood Park for lunch and will spend much of the day here. The trip is free but again, they WILL need a **packed lunch**. If you are wanting school to provide a lunch for your child who usually has a school dinner, please let me know.

Wednesday 14th July – Sleepover. The arrangements are just as before but they do not need picking up the following morning as Thursday is a normal school day. Please bring them to school for **no earlier than 6:15pm**. They will have pizza, popcorn, time outside and a film. They need to remember sleeping stuff (pyjamas, mat/bed, pillow, sleeping bag/cover), toothbrush and toothpaste, PE kit for the next day and anything else they need for sleeping. Devices are NOT allowed. If you have not already paid the £2.50, please do so via ParentPay ASAP. Thank you for all the signed slips – I have received them all 😊



Thursday 15th July – Sports Morning. We will spend the morning doing our Year 5 and 6 sports morning.

Friday 16th July – Saltburn-by-the-Sea. This is the rearranged trip from June and the details remain the same (please refer to previous letter in terms of what the children need) **The children need to be at school for 8:05am** as we are leaving at 8:15am. The school day will end as normal. The children will be having a chippy lunch on the pier but as I have mentioned previously, if you do not want them to have this due to their dietary needs, please contact the office for a £1.50 refund. The cost of this trip is £26 and if you have not already paid, please do so via ParentPay ASAP.

Monday 19th July – Leavers Assembly. We will be filming our leavers assembly which will be shared with you all.

Thursday 22nd July – Church Service. The finer details of this are currently being put together and a separate letter will be sent to you.

I know that the last month for the children has been hugely disrupted but fingers crossed, the final two weeks will be fun and a chance for them to enjoy their final days at St Chad's.
