



OREGON CONFERENCE ADVENTURER CLUB POINT SYSTEM

CLUB REGISTRATION = 40 PTS

Turn in Club Registration forms by October 30 of each year as well as the required Volunteer Information forms. Registration is required to qualify for the Club of the Year Award.

BIANNUAL REPORTS= 40 PTS EACH (TOTAL 80 PTS POSSIBLE)

Reports are due twice a year

INDUCTION SERVICE= 30 PTS

Adventurers and Staff dress in class "A" Uniform for this event.

BASIC/ADVANCED STAFF TRAINING = 50 PTS

*All of your staff in attendance gives your club an **additional 10 pts**.

ADV. ADVISORY MEETING ATTENDANCE= 30 PTS EACH MEETING (90 PTS POSSIBLE)

Advisory Meetings are for Club Directors and Associate Directors. At least one of these leaders should be in attendance. If that is not possible another staff member may represent the club. See Calendar for dates and locations.

ADV. STAFF RETREAT PARTICIPATION=50 PTS

The Adv. Staff Retreat will be held at Big Lake Youth Camp. The directors and staff are encouraged to attend. *Early registration for this event is **an additional 10 pts**.

INVESTITURE PROGRAM=40 PTS

If you would like a District Consultant or Conference Representative to take part in the service please let them know well in advance. Weekend dates fill up quickly.

ADVENTURER FAMILY FUN DAY PARTICIPATION= 50 PTS

Staff and Adventurer children should be in field uniform. ***An additional 30 pts** is earned for taking charge of a station or the food preparation.

ADVENTURER SABBATH= 20 PTS

Children should be highly involved and dressed in "class A" uniform

COMMUNITY OUTREACH ACTIVITIES= 20 PTS EACH

Possible activities might be earning your Evangelism award, taking cards to shut-ins, helping a needy family, planting flowers for your town (beautification project) etc.

FACEBOOK ENTRY SUBMITTED= 30 PTS EACH

Take a few pictures and write a description of a fun idea you used in your club. Send it to our office so that we can post it on facebook or just write your idea in the comments on the Oregon Adventurer Facebook Page. You could also share something God has been doing through your club. Perhaps it is something your club did to reach the community or maybe a "God Sighting" (a testimony of how you saw God working in your club)
