

Rock Climbing Rules

1. Supervisor must be present when climbing.
2. Climber must be protected by a top belay.
3. Belayer must be approved by climbing instructor.
4. Belayer must be at least eighteen years of age or be supervised one on one with an instructor that is approved by the director.
5. Belayer must use an approved mechanical belay device.
6. Helmets and approved harnesses are required.
7. No street shoes or bare feet allowed.
8. Rappelling must be done on belay.
9. No more than one climber per route.
10. Climbers must be at least thirteen years of age.
