Registration & Deadline

Registration with the Conference Pathfinder Office by **January 5, 2019** is required to participate in the Bible Experience program. Clubs are to use the form below.

Pathfinder Uniform

All Pathfinders participating at any Bible Experience Level must wear their Class-A uniform including sash even if they have no honors on it.

Participants will receive a pin from the Conference Pathfinder office for their uniform that is worn on the left uniform pocket. For each level you participate in you will also receive a bar.

Levels

Each team must earn a 1st place award to qualify for participation at the next level. However not all clubs that receive a 1st place award will choose to participate in the next level due to travel or expenses.

District Level – January 19, 2019

Confirm this date and the location with your District Coordinators. They are responsible for planning this level and facilitating the event. All teams achieving a 1st and 2nd place awards are eligible to participate in the Conference level.

NOTE: A Pathfinder club may have multiple teams participate at the District Level.

Conference Level – February 9, 2019

The location will be at a Pleasant Hill Seventh-day Adventist Church. The Conference is responsible for planning this level and will follow the guidelines as outlined in the PBE manual. All teams achieving a 1st place award are eligible to participate in the Union level.

NOTE: A Pathfinder club may have multiple teams participate at the Conference Level.

Union Level – March 9, 2019

Union level will be hosted by Idaho Conference, location to be determined. All teams achieving a 1st place award are eligible to participate in the Division level.

NOTE: A Pathfinder club may have multiple teams participate at the Union Level.

Division Level – April 26-27, 2019

Division level will be **held at Rock Valley College in Rockford, Illinois.** (More info will be coming.)

NOTE: A Pathfinder club may have multiple teams participate at the Division Level.
