

What is Post Impressionism? • Henri was a self-taught painter Between 1886 and 1905 • He was a tax collector 'Post' means 'after' so post-impressionism • He did not start painting seriously until he was 40 and came after impressionism did not become a full time artist until he was 49 • Impressionist painters liked to paint real life subjects with bright colours and thick • He loved painting rainforests but never visited one. paint so you can see the brush strokes • He painted house plants and plants from books • Post-impressionists painted in a similar way • During his lifetime, many people did not think his but also wanted to express their feelings in paintings were very good but later on, people said he the painting by using unusual colours.
