


National Mobile Care Initiative

Making Oral Health Care Accessible to More Families


Through the National Mobile Outreach Initiative, sponsored by Patterson Dental, America's ToothFairy clinical partners overcome these barriers to care by providing dental services in mobile units, schools and childcare facilities, community centers and other familiar settings. By meeting underserved families where they live, work, learn and play, children who may otherwise have fallen through the cracks receive critical preventive and restorative oral health care.
