




Welcome Back Year One

Who will be teaching me?


Miss Pritchard will be your class teacher. Miss Price, who usually teaches Year 3, and Mrs Smith will also be working in our class too.

Which classroom will I be working in?

You will be in the Year 1/2 classroom. Each morning you gather at our meeting point on the field and stand on a cone. You will be collected by your adult at the same place. You will have your own learning space, desk and equipment to use and your coat will be kept on your chair.

What time will I start school and when will I finish school?

So that there aren't too many people coming in and out of school at the same time, different classes will be starting and finishing school at different times. You will start school at 8:50am and finish school at 3:00pm. **On Fridays, school will close early, you will need to be collected at 12:00pm on this day.**

Who can I play with at break times?

At break times, each class group will have an equipment box and zone on the playground that is theirs. You can play with other children in your class group.



What will learning be like?

You will still have your familiar lessons and routines like Maths, English, Phonics and story time. There will also be opportunities for fun learning games too.

What will I need to remember to stay safe?
