



Attendance: *All day, every day will take you all the way!*

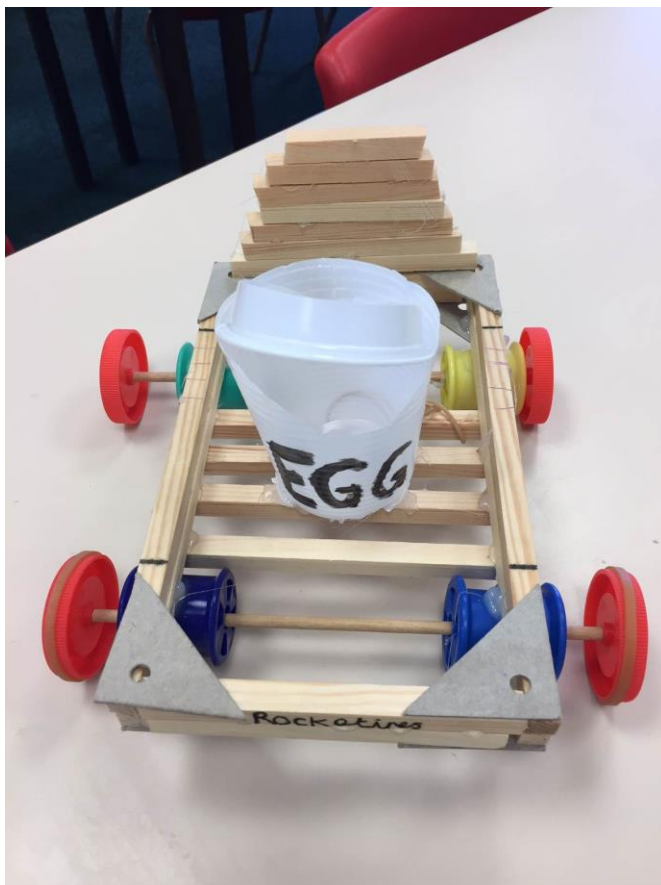
