Dear Sir, Madam,

As you are no doubt aware Vistry Homes has planning permission to develop 250 homes on the land to the rear of Woodpits Lane and Aspreys all of which will be accessed off Yardley Road.

Before the main infrastructure and house building works start we have to carry out an archaeological investigation and some further trial hole investigations. We plan to start these works on 15th June.

The works will involve some soil clearance and mostly shallow digging in parts of the site. The equipment used will be an excavator and smaller support vehicles (Land Rovers, vans etc). Operatives will also be bringing their own vehicles. All of the operative parking and investigation works will take place on site with the exception of the first few days whilst the site is being set up. There should be no more than 10 to 15 people on site whilst these works are carried out.

We anticipate that the works will take about 10 weeks to complete.

All work will be carried out in accordance with current Government guidelines on COVID-19.

These are investigation works only and are not part of the construction process for the development. We will let you know when the main development works are due to start at a later date.
