

PUBLIC NOTICE

THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MILTON KEYNES (EAST STREET (PART) AND PALMERS ROAD (PART), OLNEY) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2020

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the Borough of Milton Keynes intends, in not less than seven days from the date of this Notice, to make the above Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicles from entering, waiting or proceeding along **East Street and Palmers Road, Olney** at its junction with Near Town to Excavate to lay approx. 20 metres of duct.

The above closure will come into effect on 14th September 2020 and is scheduled to be reopened on 16th September 2020.

The closure will be in place between the hours of 9:30am and 4:30pm, the closure will then be lifted between the hours of 4:30pm and 9:30am every day.

Whilst the above length of road is closed the alternative route (diversion route) will be via East Street, Holes Lane, High Street and Silver End (and vice versa).

The temporary road closure and diversion route can be viewed at www.roadworks.org.

The Council is satisfied that the temporary closure Order is necessary to enable works to be carried out on the highway. The temporary Order will come into effect on 14th September 2020 and will take effect at times during the above period **only** when works are required and **only** when indicated by the appropriate traffic signs, which will be erected in advance of any closure.

There will be no exemptions from the provisions of the proposed Order except for emergency service vehicles on operational duties and residents.

The closures will be clearly signed in accordance with Chapter 8 of the Traffic Signs Manual. All affected properties will be notified of the forthcoming closures at least one week prior to works taking place.

Any person committing a breach of the order will be liable upon prosecution to such fine as is prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
