

Assessment Arrangements

Ongoing assessment should be an integral part of the daily routine. Everyone should be observing children and responding appropriately to help them make progress. Observations are made against each criterion for the Foundation Stage Curriculum.

Every half term, the key worker must fill out the assessment for each child to monitor their key children's progress and report this information to parents through a parent teacher meeting. This is where targets are mutually set up between the parent and key worker, into the individual educational plan which is reviewed every half term during parent teacher meeting.
