3. Business as follows:
 - Reading of Sept. 2019 minutes – addition and corrections made – board approved.
 - New SCSEP person hired through the NACOG SCSEP Program – will begin Monday October 7, 2019 – Deborah De Marco – 20 hours per week, this is our second person through this program
 - Banner - we have received 1 volunteer this month, Volunteer route driver
 - Ally McDowell is the social media replacement and she is with White Mountain Independent newspaper
 - Steve connected with the Pinetop City Manager – they discussed whether or not we could place a banner in Pinetop - this was rejected –
 - School buses - Blue Ridge School District – is still in the works for Meals on Wheels advertisement – there is a MOW banner hanging on the school fence
 - Wiley reports on the car cavalcade video – he was not satisfied with the video and will credit us as portion of the \$1,000.00 - which was the cost for this advertising program
 - Denny's Fund Raiser – Great people there and they continue to promote us and said they would like to do this event yearly.
 - We have received donations from several churches this month
 - We have had a FREE lunch potato bar specifically for the apartment people, to see what response we would get – 16 attended out of 46 apartments
 - for board information – we had 3200 people come through center last quarter and served 3150 lunches combined MOW program and dining room
 - we continue to investigate the possibility in delivering to White Mountain Lakes area...we just need additional drivers

 - Film Festival in Pinetop - October 18 this is hosting movies that are up and coming –
 - Sue reports about the Star Bucks food program – its going very well and they donate bags of pastries and sandwiches which we utilize for MOW and our dining room
 - October 26 – Summit Health Expo – we have contracted a booth with Wiley and he will be there from 10-2pm – This event will cover Alzheimer’s and Dementia –and attending this will help us build our relationship with Summit
