
## HOW TO BUILD YOUR OWN FOLD-UP CASTLE


## YOU'LL REED:


Large cardboard packing box (from a chair or fridge), Velcro self-adhesive tape, PVA glue, craft knife, scissors, ruler, marker pen, paints and brushes.


## TOP TIP - TOP TIP

Cut some slits in the walls to keep a look-out for approaching enemy armies.











Mark out battlements and a drawbridge (on a side with a flap).



Carefully cut them out, leaving the bottom of the drawbridge to form a hinge. Fold the bottom flaps under the box.



Glue a cut-off flap inside the top of the opening. Glue another to the inside of the drawbridge door so you can pull it shut.



Paint the whole box with PVA diluted with three times the amount of water and allow it to dry. Stick Velcro where shown.



Paint to look like stone and wood. Give a final coat of diluted PVA for extra strength. The castle will fold flat to store.
