HOW TO MAKE A FINGERSAUR

Imagine your finger as the long neck of a plant-eating dinosaur! Make the frill and turn it into a triceratops. Put one on each finger and have a whole dinosaur family.





TRICERATOPS MEANS THREE-HORNED FACE.

YOU'LL REED:

For the dinosaur:

face paints.

For the triceratops:

paper, tracing paper, masking tape, scissors, pencil, paints and brushes or crayons, sticky tape.



DINOSAUR








Paint your hand and a little face on your index finger.



With your thumb and middle finger as the legs, pull your sleeve down and let your dinosaur go for a walk.






Copy the templates on to paper (see inside front cover for instructions).



Cut out. Folding them in half first makes this easier. Colour them in (see page 23).







Cut the slits in the horns as shown. Put sticky tape on the back first to stop them tearing. Slot one into the other.



Put the frill on first, then the horns. Paint an extra horn on your finger face to make a 'tri' ceratops.
