



Rising to the Occasion

2020 brought us all unique challenges as **together** we faced our first global pandemic. Reflecting on the Amigos of Costa Rica journey through 2020, this time of fear and uncertainty was met with generosity and care. The number of donations we received increased over 300%, with many donors expressing their gratitude for having the opportunity to support people and communities they care about. Community organizations that had previously come together to help one another after floods or landslides once again organized rapidly to care for those in need.

This past year was characterized by **stories of connection**; by our need as human beings to care for one another. Donations poured in from tourists who fondly remembered the communities they had visited. A hotel developer (of a project now more than a decade old) generously contributed salaries for out-of-work staff at the property that he had worked on so many years ago. Those with a connection to Costa Rica reached out to their friends and family asking to help in supporting places dear to their hearts, and even those who had never been to Costa Rica donated - simply because someone they care about asked.

While in the midst of the pandemic, Amigos of Costa Rica also went through a significant change and was reclassified as an independent public charity in the United States. Initially established in the year 2000 as a supporting organization of the CRUSA Foundation, Amigos of Costa Rica will continue to collaborate with CRUSA and receive financial support from CRUSA while it works towards increasing financial sustainability.

Amigos of Costa Rica continues to play a vital role in facilitating the flow of funds from donors around the world to high quality nonprofit solutions in Costa Rica's communities. 2020 demonstrated a strong continued interests of donors to engage with Costa Rica, and Amigos of Costa Rica is well positioned to continue to provide opportunities for authentic connection with Costa Rica through philanthropy.





In 2020, people from 42 countries celebrated their connection with Costa Rica by donating



 More than 5000 donations were received in 2020, an increase of over 300% over 2019

 90 nonprofit organizations received funding through their relationship with Amigos of Costa Rica, and increase from 62 organizations in 2019

Connection During COVID-19

Resilient Costa Rica & Proactive Testing

To address the myriad of challenges created by the COVID-19 Pandemic, the CRUSA Foundation rapidly worked with partners, including Amigos of Costa Rica, to establish two programs: Resilient Costa Rica and ProActive Testing. The Resilient Costa Rica Program allowed Amigos of Costa Rica to collaborate with community organizations in their COVID-19 relief efforts around the country. From food aid, to supporting continued access to local medical care, to direct economic aid the Resilient Costa Rica program connected donors from around the world with community organizations that were providing a true life-line to those impacted economically by the pandemic. The ProActive Testing Program gave donors the opportunity to support Costa Rica's pandemic response through the purchase of both tests and testing equipment.

Feeding Costa Rican Families

When COVID-19 caused Costa Rica's international airports to close on March 18, 2020, overnight the country's tourism economy ground to a halt. By June, Costa Rica's unemployment rate hit a historic high of 24%. Through the **CRUSA Foundation's Resilient Costa Rica Program**, Amigos of Costa Rica was able to contribute to efforts that supported **9,500 families** with over **120,000** packages of food aid. In the majority of cases, food was distributed by grass roots organizations working in their own communities.

Impact Summaries



While many nonprofit organizations in Costa Rica added programs to contribute to COVID-19 relief efforts, their ongoing work around the country didn't stop. Amigos of Costa Rica received funds for organizations focusing on a wide variety of impact areas.



Conservation and Restoration

Many Amigos of Costa Rica Affiliate Organizations continued their efforts in conservation, working to restore both habitats and vulnerable populations. Funds received from Amigos of Costa Rica contributed to the important impact that these organizations had throughout the year, with some organizations reporting that the only funds received in 2020 came from Amigos of Costa Rica donors.

Sustainable Agriculture and Environmental Education



With the challenges of the global pandemic came additional challenges: pressure on local natural resources as economic opportunities swiftly disappeared. A desire to increase local self sufficiency in the face of global uncertainty fueled creative programs around the country. Many Amigos of Costa Rica Affiliate Organizations launched community gardens, often providing opportunities for unemployed tourism workers to serve their communities. Organizations also focused on renewing efforts to support local conservation efforts in the face of increased pressure on resources.

Investing in our future

Throughout the year, Amigos of Costa Rica Affiliate Organizations worked to support youth in many ways. Many Costa Rican children were educated remotely receiving monthly packets of educational materials. We heard stories of Affiliate Organizations helping parents brush up on their reading skills so that those parents could better help their children with their educations. The community of **San Josecito** was able to have internet connectivity for the first time thanks to the generosity of a neighboring community. Through **TeenSmart**'s online platform, youth were able to stay connected with their dreams for the future. **Amigos del Aprendizaje** helped teachers improve their skills in literacy education through remote trainings. The **David Kitson Library** worked to support families engaged in remote education and supplied reading materials. The generosity of Amigos of Costa Rica donors contributed to these organizations' abilities to implement these important programs.


Supporting Nonprofit Leaders

In Memoriam: Harry Odio

Longtime Amigos of Costa Rica board member Harry Odio passed away in October of 2020. Below is an excerpt from a board resolution made in his honor
