PRESCHOOL OVERVIEW

Curriculum

The Saint Anselm Early Childhood Education Program (SAECEP) curriculum is designed to meet the needs of the growing whole child. To meet those needs, SAECEP provides activities to enhance each child's spiritual, social, emotional, and physical development. SAECEP offers experiences in literature, math, science, social studies, art, music, religion, and physical education to further enhance students' social interaction and intellectual development. The day school also provides the opportunity for students to attend gym, art, and music weekly. Saint Anselm Early Childhood Education Program follows the curriculum as set by the Diocese of Cleveland. This curriculum is aligned with and contains the standards as established by the Ohio Department of Education. In addition, the faculty and staff follow guidelines from the National Association for the Education of the Young Child. (NAEYC).

Schedule Options

St. Anselm Early Childhood Education Program offers several options for preschool students and their parents.

Three year old students may pick 3 full or half days. Four year old students may pick a 3, 4, or 5 half or full day session.

Full day drop in is also available. While the main portion of learning takes place in the morning half of the day, full day students enjoy the added benefit of extension and enrichment activities that enhance their learning experience.

Full day students may either bring their own packed lunch or buy a lunch from the school cafeteria. All day students will rest for 60 minutes each afternoon. Each student should bring a yoga mat, blanket and pillow from home to be used during rest time. Rest items will be sent home periodically for cleaning and must be returned the following session.

Is there a snack time?

The school morning is so full of learning and activities; there is no time for a snack. You may send your child in with a labeled water bottle to drink from during the day.

For half day students, we also offer lunch bunch program. Daily, the preschool students may bring their lunches and spend some extra time with their friends from 11:00 dismissal until 12:00 p.m. The cost of the program is \$10.00/day.

Busing

While the local school districts provide transportation for Saint Anselm School, there is no busing for SAECEP. Parents are responsible for transportation of their child to and from school.

Does my child need to be Catholic?

No, your child does not need to be Catholic, but we do practice a daily religion lesson, prayers, and conversation. All children, of any faith, are welcome.

Uniforms

SAECEP does not require a uniform, but encourages clothing that will complement the learning environment. SAECEP is designed to promote learning and exploration. The children climb, crawl, dance, ride bikes, use clay, paint, and markers, sit on rugs, and often go outdoors. Keep these activities in mind while planning washable, comfortable, simple clothing for school.

Do students attend fieldtrips?

SAECEP offers field trips to enrich each child's learning experience. The field trips may vary from year to year based upon the children's interests and available opportunities. We typically offer two field trips each school year. Because of the unique travel and supervision demands of a field trip, we ask that parents drive and attend with their child.
