Topic: Boys, Girls, Families

Date: Summer 2

Week	Learning Objectives
1	<p>Pupils learn to understand and respect the differences and similarities between people.</p> <p>Pupils are able to define difference and similarity.</p> <p>Pupils understand that boys and girls can do the same tasks and enjoy the same things – challenge stereotypes.</p>
2	<p>Pupils learn about the biological differences between male and female animals and their role in the life cycle.</p> <p>Pupils know that female mammals give birth and nurse their young.</p>
3	<p>Pupils learn the biological differences between male and female children.</p> <p>Pupils can name the biological terms for male and female sex parts.</p>
4	<p>Pupils learn about growing from young to old and that they are growing and changing.</p> <p>Pupils can identify key stages in the human life cycle.</p> <p>Pupils can understand some ways they have changed since they were babies.</p> <p>Pupils can understand that all living things including humans start life as babies.</p>
5	<p>Pupils learn that everybody needs to be cared for and ways in which they care for others.</p> <p>Pupils understand that we have different needs and require different types of care.</p> <p>Pupils can identify ways we show care towards each other.</p> <p>Pupils understand the link between needs, caring and changes throughout the life cycle.</p>
6	<p>Pupils learn about different types of family and how their home life is special.</p> <p>Pupils can describe different types of family.</p> <p>Pupils can identify what is special about their home life.</p> <p>Pupils can understand families care for each other in a variety of ways.</p>
