

Year 1 Newsletter Autumn 1—2019/2020

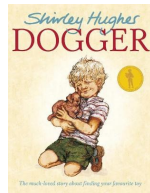
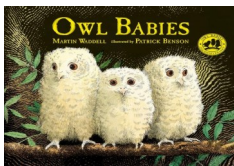
This half term's topic is: Memory Box

In **English** we will be:

- Retelling simple stories using actions.
- Using adjectives to describe.
- Writing our own version of the story 'Owl Babies'.

Books that we will look at in depth are:

- Dogger
- Owl Babies
- Puddles Big Step



In **Maths** we will be:

- Counting to 10
- Number bonds to 10
- Addition and subtraction
- Counting numbers to 20
- Counting, reading and writing numbers

In **Topic** we will:

- Create a memory box in D&T.
- In **History** we will compare toys from the past and present.
- Compose questions about artefacts.
- Order different modes of transport on a timeline.
- In **Science**, we will be locating and talking about the five senses.
- Identifying and classifying childhood objects and everyday use.

In **R.E.** The children will be learning about what God is like linking to their understanding of a variety of parables.

In **Music** we will be learning about the differences between pulse, rhythm and pitch and to learn how to rap and enjoy it in its original form.

In **Art** we will be focusing on self portraits. The children will explore techniques with sketching and painting.
