RE: The Flying Squadron Predator workshop.

Dear Parent/carer

As part of our Predator topic, On **Wednesday 23rd October** we have an exciting visitor coming to school. The Flying Squadron! The children will have the opportunity to see real live predators and their prey. During the workshop they will meet Xena The Barn Owl, Frankie The Bengal Eagle, Lilly The Rabbit and Louis The Lizard and learn about why they are built to be predators and why their prey have certain features in order to try and escape!

The children will experience seeing the Eagle in flight and the owl up close and will carefully study their features to learn about what makes them a good predator. The birds are extremely well trained and they are used to audiences so they pose no threat to the children and will be kept at a suitable distance under the care of the handler. The children will not be allowed to handle them, however, they will get the opportunity to handle the rabbits and the lizard under supervision.
