



## Year 1 Newsletter Spring 2—2019/2020

### This half term's topic is: Enchanted Forests

In **English** we will be:

- Reciting and learning a version of 'The Three Little Pigs' and 'Jack and the Beanstalk'.
- Re-telling and adapting familiar traditional stories.
- Writing our own version of a traditional tale.
- Reading and sequencing sentences from familiar stories.

**Books that we will look at in depth are:**

- Jack and the Beanstalk
- The Three Little Pigs
- Snow White



In **Maths** we will be:

- Solving addition and subtraction problems using numbers to 20.
- Solving missing number problems to 20.
- Counting, reading, writing numbers to 100 in numerals **and words**.
- Knowing doubles facts and recording them.
- Partitioning numbers into tens and ones.

In **Science** we will:

- Identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants.
- Identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants.
- Use observations and ideas to suggest answers to questions.
- Gather and record data to help answer questions.
- Identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees.

In **R.E.** we will be learning about Salvation and thinking about the key question: Why does Easter matter to Christians?

In **Music** we will be learning about pulse, pitch and rhythm in Latin music. The children will be linking it to singing and using instruments.

In **Art** we will be looking at the artist Georgia O'Keefe and exploring line and form. We will also be practising painting techniques inspired by the artist Georges Seurat and the pointillist movement.

This half term, **P.E.** will be on Wednesday and outdoor PE on a Friday. Please ensure your child has outdoor P.E kit.

In **Computing** we will be working on grouping and creating and interpreting pictograms.
