School of Atelier Ballet COVID-19 Protocols - REVISED AUGUST 13, 2020

Registration will be on a first signed-up, first served basis. We request all students register for the entire term. Please bring a cheque or cash to your first class. Please remember, it is important you attend the classes you sign up for! The number of students we are allowed is very restricted and we don't want anyone to miss out because someone has not attended.

St. Lawrence Hall will be locked at all times, so School of Atelier Ballet staff will wait downstairs from 30 minutes prior to class time to let you in. **Please arrive at least five minutes before class begins.**

We request that you observe physical distancing if you are waiting outside. St. Lawrence Hall will provide markers on the sidewalk. Before entering one at a time, you must fill out a screening form provided by SAB. You must wear a mask upon entering the building and use hand sanitizer before proceeding upstairs. Only one person is allowed on the elevator at a time.

Please underdress your dance wear as we are currently restricted to one person at a time in each dressing room and washrooms. The building has requested that no one change in the washrooms.

Students will be allowed to unmask as class begins. We request that you keep your mask on your person during class if you choose not to wear it.

Physical distancing will be practiced at all times upon entering and exiting the green room and studio and during the class itself. You will be able to warm up for class in the hallway, the green room, and the studio itself in order to maintain physical distancing. We will work together to make this a priority!

All hard surfaces, such as ballet barres, will be disinfected daily and after each use.
