PRIVATE LESSONS

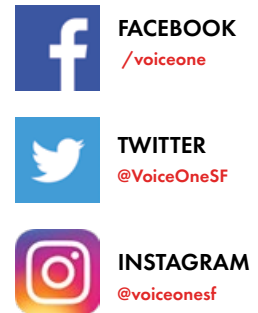
