Overall attendance for the 2019-20 school year up to the end of last week is 97.31%, so far just meeting our 97% plus target.

Last week, 10 classes achieved attendance of 97% or higher and the top 3 classes were:

On 1 May there will be a KS2 Film Night. Pop this date in your diary and look out for further details later as numbers are restricted and it's sure to be a very popular event!

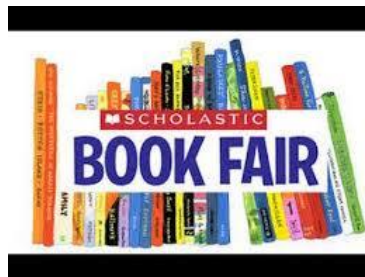

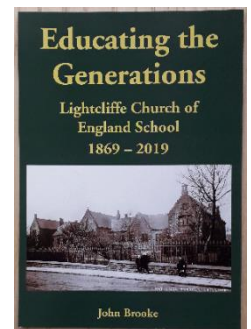
WORLD BOOK DAY 2020 - What a fabulous day we had today. Your children looked amazing! Thank you for all the effort you put into making today so special.
