Overall attendance for the 2019-20 school year up to the end of last week is 97.35%, so far just meeting our 97% plus target.

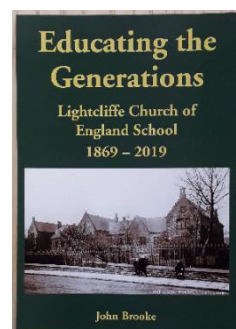
