

SWIMMING AT LIGHTCLIFFE CE PRIMARY — 2020-2021

In accordance with the National Curriculum, schools must provide swimming instruction either in Key Stage 1 or Key Stage 2.

The programme of study for PE sets out the expectation that pupils should be taught to:

- swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres
- use a range of strokes effectively [for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke]
- perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations

At Lightcliffe CE Primary School our two year 4 classes receive swimming sessions for half a year each. Instructors working for Calderdale LEA. teach the children and they work towards Calderdale's awards programme.
