Returning to school from June 1st







You are probably wondering what school is going to look like when you return.





You might have already seen things on TV about how different school might look when you return and you may be feeling a little anxious or worried.



When you arrive at school.

You will arrive with one parent/adult and enter through the gate on the top playground. Parents will leave through the usual gate on the drive.







Because families have to keep a distance of 2m, we would like you to queue with your parent on the colour coded spots that have been painted on the playground.



Each year group will have a colour of their own.



At hometime, the teacher or adult will lead you outside to be collected by your parent.



The Classroom



You are likely to be working in a different room from your usual classroom but you may have worked in that room before.





The desks have to be separated to be as far apart as possible.



We have enough tables for up to 15 children in most rooms – but some tables might not be used.





Corridors

Our corridors are narrow. Where we can, we shall be moving around using a one way system. There may be times when we will have to walk past other people. To help with that, we have tape in the corridors like road markings to create two lanes.





Everyone needs to keep to the left lane – just like cars on the road. Your parents can help you prepare for walking on the left before you return to school.



Q: Who will be my teacher?

You will be organised into smaller groups so you may be working with adults that were not your teacher before but will be someone you have already seen in assemblies or out in the playground.

You may have worked with them before, but if not, it will be a good chance to get to know other adults for the future.

You will not be able to choose your group – so please do not ask.



Hygiene

We have ordered a lot of cleaning products so we are well prepared for handwashing and the extra cleaning that will be happening throughout the day.











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We have plenty of hand sanitiser for each classroom.

You do not need to bring your own.

There are posters by sinks to remind you how to wash your hands. You will be washing your hands much more often.







Playtime and Lunchtime

Each group will have a space to play on the playground or field.



You will be going out to play and having lunch at different times to some other groups so that you have plenty of space to play.



Q: What should I bring to school?

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 Your lunch (if needed) in a disposable bag or plastic lunch box.

 2) Snack - fresh fruit or vegetables.
 3) A <u>full</u> water bottle - it will be refilled at lunchtime by an adult.
 4) Coat.
 5) Hat - for sun protection. Put your

all belongings.



Sorry, but you can no longer bring <u>any</u> other items from home.

For example: Toys Books Stationery Back packs









We will all get used to things very quickly, but it will be helpful if you prepare and know what to do.

- Make sure that:
- You are wearing high factor sun-screen before you arrive at school
- You are carrying your lunch and water bottle
- Your belongings are named and your shoes laces are securely tied
- You arrive at the correct time for your group (you will be informed about your group and times closer to the days you are due to return)
- You stay with your adult when you are waiting to go inside
 you will not be able to play in the playground
- At home time, leave the school with your adult straight away you will not be able to play in the playground.



What will I be learning?

You will doing some reading/phonics, writing and maths to help prepare you for the next school year.

For children in Year 6, we shall be helping you to get ready for high school and celebrate your time at Lightcliffe in new and creative ways.

We will be helping you with any worries you may have.

We will also have some fun outdoors! We want everyone to be happy!
