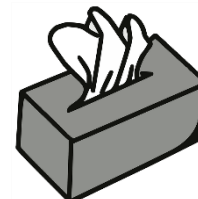




Tissue Box Book Report

We will be combining one of our most used school supplies with our summer reading book report. For this report, you will need one unopened tissue box and a fiction book that you have not read. The tissue box can be either the large or small type. **Your project is due on Wednesday, August 19 and will be graded. Please also bring your book if possible.**



Report Directions: (You may use the templates on the following pages or create your own.)

1. TOP of the Box (15 points)

- *Title (underlined), author, publisher, year published, genre, and # of pages
- *Don't cover the opening – we still want to be able to get tissues out!

2. SIDE 1: Characters (20 points)

- *Write the names and a short description of the main characters in the story
- *Questions to consider: Who are the main characters? Who did you like the most? The least? Why? Could you relate to any of the characters in the story? Have you even done some of the things or felt the same way as the characters did? Explain.

3. SIDE 2: Plot (20 points)

- *Story summary: Beginning, middle, and ending

4. SIDE 3: Setting (15 points)

- *Time(s) and place(s) in the story

5. SIDE 4: Your opinion of the story (15 points)

- *More than just “I liked it.”
- *What did you like about it? What would you have changed? What did you learn? Who would enjoy the book? What rating would you give it?

(Neatness and colorfulness are worth 5 points.)
