



All on Four Restorative Protocol

The All-on-Four procedure was developed to provide your patients with immediate function utilizing only 4 implants. At the time of initial surgery/implant placement, a screw-retained hybrid provisional is placed and maintained during implant integration. The final restoration is fabricated following adequate healing time, which allows osseointegration of the dental implants.

Items needed pre-op

Restorative dentist to provide upper and lower, bite registration, and shade. Traditional impressions are preferred. Please call S&A implant coordinator to discuss procedure and timing if using digital workflow.

Restorative Arts Dental Lab to fabricate provisional restoration with guidance from surgeon on ridge reduction. RADL will also provide clear duplicate denture to use as abutment alignment guide and putty matrix to position restoration into proper occlusion.

Day of surgery

Restorative Arts Dental Lab technician to bring appliances and assist surgeon in conversion of immediate denture, provided initial implant stabilization is achieved.

Final case procedures

Initiated approximately 4-6 months post-op, pending release from oral surgeon.

Final restoration

Appointment #1: Full arch impression(s) using copings and impressions for mounting models. RADL fabricates the working model and mounts diagnostic model of provisional to opposing. Establish VDO.

(This appointment, Final Impression, is completed at S&A with RADL Lab technician, unless restorative Doctor would prefer to assume this

Appointment #2: Esthetic try-in and bite verification. Final esthetic try in of teeth in wax, attached to milled Procera bar. (Approximately 1.5 hours)

Appointment #3: Placement of final prosthesis
