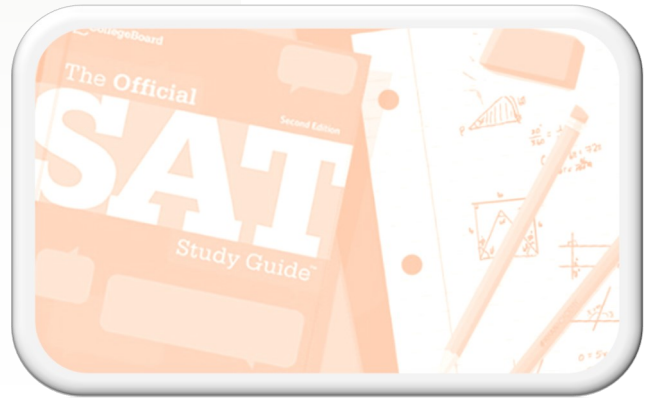


North Idaho Christian School News

School Scoop... The SAT scores are in. Congratulations to those who took the SAT, your effort is evident. The combined average SAT score for the six 11th and 12th grade students from NICS is 1210. Way to go!!! The average NICS EBRW score is 608 and the average NICS Math score is 605. The latest College Board data indicates that the **average SAT score** for graduating seniors was 1060 (533 Evidence-Based Reading and Writing (EBRW), 527 Math), which means that good **SAT scores** for **2018** are those above the **average SAT score** of 1060. Additionally, Idaho's public school combined average is 1006 and here locally the Coeur d'Alene Charter Academy combined average is 1287. What a great start to the addition of the SAT.

In Case You Missed It...

SCRIP

Scrip is simply the name given to the process of buying a gift card from the school and using it to purchase everyday items. In return NICS receives a kickback which helps keep tuition rates lower. You can purchase gift cards in the office or online. Place orders online at shopwithscrip.com and use school code C8L336F229L94. Parents that buy scrip get to deduct one hour of service time for every \$100 they spend buying scrip!! Happy Scrip-ing!

Parent Service Hours
