## INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE NOTARY ACKNOWLEDGMENT FORM

When to use: The Notary Acknowledgement Form is a generic form that may be used by an Arizona Notary Public to notarize a document. A court may require a notarized signature to verify the identity of the person signing a document before it is presented to the court.

How to use: Do not sign the form or document you want to have notarized. You will sign in the presence of the notary.

Bring the document you need to have notarized with the form to the notary public. The notary will require you to present identification. The notary public may prefer to use his or her own form. If so, the notary may use either form.
