A Pile of Suitcases

Inspired by Maarten de Ceulaer's nomadic lifestyle, A Pile of Suitcases is a modular wardrobe designed to be 'a flexible, expandable alternative' to the traditional monumental and static piece of furniture. The separate volumes can be easily dismantled—and moved—and stacked in a variety of configurations. Finished in hand-tooled leather, the cases come in various shades of green—'a natural colour', says De Ceulaer. 'It seemed an eye-catching but calming choice.' Italian manufacturer Casamania is set to produce an affordable industrial version of the piece called Valises; the designer, meanwhile, will make a luxury, limited-edition version retaining the original name, A Pile of Suitcases.
