# Rose Classes

## **Hybrid Tea (HT)**

Admired for pointed flower buds, usually a single flower per stem. Upright growth, great for cut flowers, formal or narrow borders. Usually 4 to 5 ft tall.

## **Floribunda (FL)**

Bears many flowers, smaller flowers than hybrid teas, but in large clusters. Great for containers, mixed borders, hedges, edgings or mass plantings. Bushy and more robust than Hybrid Teas. Usually 3 to 4 ft tall.

## **Grandiflora (GR)**

Larger flower form like a hybrid tea, but in clusters. Useful for screens or the back of a border. Usually 4 to 6 ft tall.

## **Climbers (CL)**

Roses that can be trained to a variety of forms. 6 to 18 ft tall.

## **Shrub Roses (SH)**

Excellent landscape plants, loaded with blooms and easy to grow. Diverse group in color, size and habit.

## **Groundcover Roses**

These are shrub roses with a more spreading habit, easy to grow. Great for low-growing mass plantings.

# General Rose Care

## **Sun**

Roses bloom the best in full sun, with at least 6 hours of sun per day.

## **Water**

Provide a slow, deep soaking, and more often in hot weather. Overhead watering, not preferred.

## **Pruning**

Remove spent blooms to encourage more flowers. Prune in early spring, before new growth begins.
