

## RULES

- All Classes in the Women's Section of the EKPMA are open to Association Members, their families and their Employees. Also to farmers, farm workers and members of a Young Farmers Club resident in the area. Classes 4 (A), 6 (A, C, D and E) and 8 (B, D, I, L and M) are Open Classes.
- All entries must be made on the printed Entry Form and Entrance Fee paid at time of entry, this form to be in the hands of the Entries Secretary **not later than Friday 23 August 2019**.
- All Exhibits to be ready for judging by 10 a.m. and must be removed between 3.30 and 4.30p.m.
- Please note vehicles are not allowed onto the showground after 9:30am.**
- No Exhibitor allowed more than One Entry in any one Section.
- The Committee have powers to add or withdraw Prizes in each Class according to number of Competitors and the merit displayed.  
The Judges will have the power to withhold Prizes where they consider the Exhibits of insufficient merit, or insufficient Entries.
- No unauthorised person will be allowed into the tent during judging.
- The Committee does not hold itself responsible for the loss of, or damage to, any Container or Exhibit.
- No Prize Money will be paid on the day of the Show. Prizes will be sent to successful Competitors.

- A. Marmalade Crumble Cake  
(made to a given recipe)

**Ingredients:**

12oz self raising flour  
6oz butter  
1 teaspoon baking powder  
4oz caster sugar  
2 medium eggs, beaten  
2 heaped tablespoons marmalade  
(approx 4oz)

Milk to mix

*For the topping*

2oz light muscovado sugar  
1 teaspoon ground cinnamon

**Method:**

Rub the butter into the sifted flour and baking powder. When the mixture resembles fine crumbs, reserve a quarter of it for the topping. Mix the marmalade and eggs with the remaining mixture adding milk if needed to give a soft dropping consistency. Pour the cake mixture into a prepared, deep 8in tin (or equivalent) and then, having mixed the brown sugar and cinnamon with the reserved crumble, sprinkle this over. Bake the cake in

a pre-heated oven 180°C/350°F/gas mark 4, for 50-60 minutes until well risen and beginning to pull from the sides of the tin. Remove from tin when cold.
