ALL ENTRIES MUST BE THE SOLE WORK OF THE ENTRANT, NO LONGER THAN 3,000 WORDS AND NOT HAVE RECEIVED AN AWARD IN ANOTHER COMPETITION.

Please provide a completed individual entry form with parental permission (attached) for each participating student. Participants must be aged 10 - 17 years old. One entry per student.

Submissions must be received between 18 October 2019 and 31 March 2020. Shortlisted writers will be listed on the Scribblers Festival website in April 2020. These finalists will be invited to take part in a writing masterclass with a Scribblers Festival guest author and attend a public awards event at which the overall prize winners will be announced.
