Flu Shot Time!

Now is the time to get your shot. You can drop-in during business hours to get it or add it on to an upcoming appointment. According to the CDC everyone age 6 months and older should get a flu vaccine every season. It is ideal to get the flu vaccine before the end of October, but still worth getting at any point in flu season. The "flu" is not just a "cold" but a severe respiratory illness that can lead to hospitalization and even death (thousands die from the flu yearly). People with diabetes, lung disease like asthma or other health conditions are even more strongly recommend to get the flu shot.
