

who?


Your students in 6th – 12th grades are eligible to join. A team consists of 2-6 students. Many churches enter more than one team for competition, so that there is more “at the buzzer” time for all students. (Because only three per team can actively compete during a quiz match.)

You will also need an adult sponsor to serve as a coach. Think outside the box of youth pastor, youth leader, or parent. You need an adult who loves spending time with junior high and/or high school students and who believes in the impact that Bible study can make on a life.

what?

Students today have many opportunities for involvement in sports, music, scholastics, church youth activities, etc.

TBQ programs can be tailored for your students who want to learn and compete over God’s word, but who cannot dedicate hours each week to memorize and compete on a track slated for National competition.



when?

League meets take place six times between October and March of each year. State Finals competition is held in April and is the last meet in Illinois. Teams who desire to compete on a Regional and National level will advance based on their records.
