## Covid-19 Health Guidelines

### 1. Word of Life Florida Youth Camp is following Federal, State and Local guidelines.

- a. If necessary, campers will be asked to bring a mask and be required to wear it in all public gatherings where social distancing guidelines cannot be followed.

### 2. Health Screening Process

- a. Pre-Screening
  - Fever free for 72 hours
  - Symptom free for 72 hours
  - Not accepting campers from NY, CT, NJ or LA.
  - Anyone having direct contact with someone who has a confirmed case of COVID-19 within the last 14-days will not be allowed to camp.
- b. Arrival at Camp Screening
  - Signed document verifying pre-screening
  - Fever/symptom check when exiting the vehicle (anyone with a fever of 100.3 or higher will not be allowed into camp).
  - If an individual camper or a camper that's part of a group fails the "Arrival Screening" the individual or the entire group will not be allowed into camp.
- c. Daily Screenings at Camp
  - Screening (fever, symptom) done by Camp staff morning and evening.
  - If a camper or staff member fails daily screening they will be quarantined and observed. (if symptoms persist the camper or staff member will be taken to the hospital to be tested)
- d. According to Federal, State and Local guidelines Word of Life Florida Youth Camp is asking those with serious underlying health conditions to not come to camp.

### 3. Cleaning Procedures

- a. Hand washing/sanitizing stations
- b. Twice daily facility cleaning using alcohol (60%) based cleaners.

### 4. Housing

- a. The CDC is recommending that facilities follow the their guideline for "homeless shelter housing". It states the following "In general sleeping areas (for those who are not experiencing respiratory symptoms), try to make sure client's faces are at least 6 feet apart." Align mats/beds so clients sleep head-to-toe.

### 5. Daily Screening of Staff

- a. All staff will be health screened upon arrival to camp.
- b. Temp/Symptom check every day for on campus and off campus staff.
- c. No sick staff are permitted to work.

### 6. Food Safety

- a. At Word of Life camps we have multiple seating's each meal to spread everyone out at a reduced occupancy in the dining hall.
- b. Each camper and staff member are required to wash and/or sanitize hands prior to entering the dining hall. A staff member is designated each mealtime to ensure proper hand hygiene protocols are followed.

### 7. Meetings

- a. Social distancing guidelines will be followed for meetings based on Federal, State and Local guidelines.

### 8. Activities

- a. Activities will be done by cabin (group) and scheduled for minimal contact.
