

Chimera Dog Policy

Both Chimera Climbing Centres are dog-friendly facilities, but we ask all dog owners to adhere to the following rules:


- Dogs must be kept off the mats at all times.
- Dogs are not allowed in the training areas, seating areas or behind the reception desk.
- Dogs must have a calm and quiet temperament, and be house-trained – whining and barking is not acceptable.
- Dogs must be kept on a short lead and under control at all times.
- All dogs must have current vaccinations.
- No aggressive dogs will be allowed in the Centre. Chimera staff have the right to ask your dog to leave at any time if they feel the dog is a threat or is not behaving well.
- Please encourage your dog to toilet before entering the facility.
- Your dog must be accompanied by a handler at all times. It is not acceptable for the dog to be left alone for any period of time.
- All dogs in the centre must have an in-date insurance policy which includes third party liability cover.

If your dog causes physical harm to anyone on our premises, they will no longer be welcome in our facility and the person affected may wish to press charges / report the incident to the police.

Owners are responsible for all property damages and/or personal injuries resulting from their dog's actions.

Owners agree to indemnify and hold harmless Chimera Climbing Centre, its owners and its operator from all liability and damage suffered as a result of their dog's actions.

Chimera Climbing Centre reserves the right to charge the dog owner commensurate to the cost of such damages.
