



Clinton, Essex, Franklin and Hamilton Counties Apprenticeship Training Program Policy

In support of career pathways, the North Country Workforce Development Board (NCWDB) provides financial support to individuals participating in Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA)-funded apprenticeship for building trade activities for required expenses related to the apprenticeship.

The NCWDB will fund the apprenticeship program(s) from Dislocated Worker, Adult and Out-of-School Youth (18 years old and older) program funds. In order for participants to be funded in an apprenticeship program, the following criteria need to apply:

1. The amount paid for apprenticeship per program year and per participant is up to \$5,000, which is part of the 35% allowable. Part of the \$5,000 per person per program year includes up to 20% for the costs of books, tools and a one-time purchase of a laptop computer.
 - a. A maximum of \$500 is allowable for the purchase of a laptop computer.
2. Increase(s) in hourly wage of a participant needs to occur for funding of future program years and be set by employer.
3. The program must result in a national, state or local license or certification leading into a career pathway.
4. Payments will be submitted to the service provider and reimbursed using WIOA funding.
5. The number of apprenticeship participants funded by WIOA per program per year will be dependent on the fiscal funding.
6. The training provider must be registered and approved on the Eligible Training Provider List (ETPL) as approved by the NCWDB staff.
