GREEN TEA

With a pure, vegetal flavor and distinctly fresh aroma, our green tea leaves are hand picked and undergo minimal oxidation to preserve their natural essence. In fact, the leaves are withered for only a short amount of time before they are heat-treated to prevent further fermentation. This preserves the natural healing attributes found in the tea leaves, most specifically, the antioxidant content.



GENMAICHA

Genmaicha is composed of Sencha and roasted popped brown rice. The distinctive taste of this tea combines the fresh grassy flavor of green tea with the aroma of roasted rice.

DRAGON WELL

The flat, green leaves of this classic "Longjing" tea produce a clear, yellow-green infusion and a lingering, pleasant aftertaste.

Lin'an County, Zhejiang Province, China.



GUNPOWDER

Also known as the "Green Pearl", this classic green tea is made from tea leaves hand-rolled into tiny pellets. When steeped, the liquor exhibits a dark golden color, a strong roasted, smoky flavor, and a very unique aroma.

Shaoxing County, Zhejiang Province, China.



CHUNMEE

The long, fine, jade leaves of this tea produce a clear, pale yellow liquor, and a sweet plum-like flavor with toasty notes.

Chun'an County, Zhejiang Province, China.



MAOJIAN

Hand harvested tea leaf tips are rolled into a pointy shape, resembling a strand of hair. This tea is known for its delicate, subtly sweet taste, and fragrant aroma.

MORE GREEN TEAS



SENCHA

This steamed green tea is famous for its fresh taste and aroma. The steaming process minimizes the oxidation of tea leaves, making this a quintessential tea with bright green liquor, sweet taste and a clean finish.

Yiwu County, Zhejiang Province, China.



JASMINE PEARLS

Artfully crafted from the finest silver tips of tender young buds, this tea is hand-rolled into pearls and naturally scented with the essence of fresh jasmine blossoms. The pearls boast a full-bodied yet sweet taste with a lingering floral note.

Fuzhou County, Fujian Province, China.



GYOKURO

Also known as "Precious Jade Dew", it is the highest quality shade-grown Japanese-style green tea. Due to reduced sunlight, minimal photosynthesis occurs, resulting in increased amounts of amino acids, chlorophyll and caffeine. This impacts the color, taste and aroma, producing a sweet, delicate tea with a soft, mellow body.

MATCHA

Matcha is a type of finely-powdered green tea made of Tencha - a specially treated shade-grown tea that is high in chlorophyll and low in tanning. When Tencha tea leaves are de-veined, de-stemmed, and ground into fine, emerald-green, talc-like powder, the final product is known as Matcha.

Zhejiang Province, China.



WHITE TEA

The rarest of all teas, white tea is delicate in flavor as well as color. The tea has a subtle, sweet flavor and a mellow nutty body. White tea receives its name from the delicate leaf tip that blooms in early Spring. These young tea leaves are harvested when a white down covering appears. After they are plucked, minimal processing occurs, preserving a high concentration of antioxidants and ensuring low caffeine levels.



SILVER NEEDLE

These young white tea buds deliver a delicate aroma with a floral note. Taste is smooth, light and sweet at first sip, but finishes with a fleeting smoky hint.

BAI MU DAN

A sweet, mild tea with a golden and bright liquor. The flavor offers a clean, floral taste with a hint of fruit.

Fuding County, Fujian Province, China.



PUERH TEA

A regionally endemic and famous tea produced traditionally in the Yunnan Province, Puerh Tea is processed from the fresh leaves of a superior "large leaf" variety of *Camellia sinensis* and it experiences a unique natural post-fermentation process. This tea is famous for its feature of "longer steep time, better aroma" which is its most important feature and distinguishes it from other teas. Puerh is called the "edible antique" and in China people believe it will increase in value over time.



PUERH LEAF

When steeped, this tea exhibits a dark reddish infusion with a strong earthy scent, an aged essence and sweet undertones.

Jinuo County, Yunnan Province, China.



OO LONG TEA

Referred to as the "Champagne of Teas", oolong is considered to be among the finest. The cultivation of authentic oolong tea is restricted to a small area of Southeastern China's Fujian and Guangdong Provinces. The tea leaves are handpicked and then partially fermented, yielding a range of flavors; some are mild with a floral aroma, while others may be more full-bodied and toasty.



SHUI XIAN

Produced using the top three to four leaves on the branch, this tea is hand rolled into its final shape. When brewed, the infusion has an amber color with an exquisite floral fragrance. The taste is smooth and lightly sweet with a subtle dryness reminiscent of pear skin followed by a lightly baked aftertaste.

TIE KUAN YIN

As a legendary variety, Tie Kuan Yin is considered the masterpiece of oolong tea. The lovely orchid-like aroma fills the air after steeping. The taste offers a honey-like sweetness with a hint of floral notes.
Fujian Province, China.



WUYI ROCK OOLONG

This tea is a premium variety of Chinese oolong tea. The aroma is clean like green tea with an osmanthus flower note, but the taste is sweet and mellow like black tea.
Wuyi Mountains, Fujian Province, China.



BLACK TEA

Black tea is the most common type of tea worldwide. The tea is prepared by fully fermenting the harvested tea leaves prior to undergoing heat-treatment. This fermentation/oxidation process imparts a full-bodied flavor, delicate aroma, characteristic reddish-brown color, and higher caffeine content to the black tea.



KEEMUN

The most famous variety of Chinese black tea featured by its distinctive and balanced taste. This tea is fresh and sweet, with fruity aroma and a hint of orchid.

Anhui Province and Fuliang, Jiangxi Province, China.



BLACK MAO FENG

This black tea has twisted thin leaves with russet color and velvet texture. The taste is rich and lingering with a note of subtle dark chocolate and sweet orchid.

Zhejiang Province, China.



ORANGE PEKOE

Regarded as the quintessence of Anhui black tea, this excellent quality tea offers a dark, glossy, bright-red liquor, and a honey aroma with flowery fragrance.

Dongtai County, Anhui Province, China.



YUNNAN BLACK

The leaves of this tea have a unique long, closely formed fat shape, showcasing golden downy pekoe. The taste is fine and smooth, though slightly tart.

Yunnan Province, China.



LAPSANG SOUCHONG

Famous for its characteristic smoky aroma, this tea is dried over a smoking pine fire, imparting the finished product with a sweet and clean smoky flavor.

Fujian Province, China.

PREMIUM ORGANIC LONG JING (DRAGON WELL)

Regarded as the "Tea of China", this tea is celebrated for having 4 characteristics - green in color, rich in fragrance, sweet in taste, and beautiful in appearance. This can be specifically described as jade green with a yellowish tint color, gentle and long-lasting orchid aroma, sweet, pure and refreshing taste with sharpened straight, flat, smooth and even shape.

Hangzhou, Zhejiang Province, China.



PREMIUM ORGANIC MAO FENG

Produced in tea gardens with excellent environmental conditions: fertile and porous soil, year-round enshrouding mist and rippling springs that enrich the soil, the tea leaves are tender with silvery hairs covering on the surface. The infusion of this tea is in jade green color, and of elegant fragrance.

PREMIUM BLACK

PREMIUM ORGANIC FU LIANG HONG

Produced in an area nicknamed the "Porcelain Capital", this black tea exudes a noticeable aroma and texture, which leaves a long-lasting refreshing flavor on the palate.

Produced in the Yunnan Province, Puerh is named the "edible antique". Due to the natural post-fermentation process, Puerh tea has a reddish-brown appearance and the color is bright, dense with a brown-reddish tint when infused. It has a special ripened aroma and a sweet mellow aftertaste that improves with age.

PREMIUM OOLONG

PREMIUM DA HONG PAO (BIG RED ROBE)

Processed in the scenic Wuyi Mountains, this tea grows among rocks and streams in the higher altitude and mountain tops. In appearance it is tight and robust with a shade of green and bloom. When infused, its liquor is deep yellow and bright in color which also gives off an unique osmanthus-like fragrance and leaves a pleasant mouthful of sweet aftertaste.

PREMIUM TIE KUAN YIN (IRON GODDESS OF MERCY)

Mainly processed in Anxi County, which has typical tropical monsoon climate of South Asia, the exceptional and superior environment contributes to the unique characteristics of Tie Kuan Yin: tightly curled in shape, and dark jade green in color. Once steeped, it smells like orchid, and tastes sweet with a refreshing, mild but lasting floral.

PREMIUM DONG DING (FROZEN SUMMIT)

Cultivated from the region of Dongding Mountain with an elevation around 700-1,200 meters, plenty of mist and moderate sun light, this tea is the magnum opus of the semi-fermented Taiwan oolongs, noted for its big half sphere appearance, refreshing infusion, and deep amber liquor with long-lasting aromatic sweet flavor.

PREMIUM FENG HUANG DAN CONG (PHOENIX OOLONG)

Produced in the Phoenix Mountain located next to the East China Sea with terrain fully landscaped by trees and endowed by an abundance of rainfall and fertile soil, this keen environment allows for the tea trees to provide rich polyphenols and aromatic properties Phoenix Oolong is known for. The tea leaves are a sturdy shade of red with glossy foliage. When brewed, the tea releases a superb natural fragrance and a flavor of fresh, mellow bliss.

PREMIUM GINSENG OOLONG

Ginseng oolong is processed with premium oolong tea and ginseng. It retains not only the mellow taste of oolong tea but also a honey sweet taste derived from ginseng. It is refreshingly mild with a long-lasting floral aftertaste.

PREMIUM WEN SHAN BAO ZHONG

Historically, Bao Zhong is from Wen Shan District which represents the top of the line quality. That is why it is called "Wen Shan Bao Zhong" customarily. This tea represents the least processed of the Taiwan oolong teas. The long, twisted emerald colored tea leaves provide a fresh, clear green and delicate infusion with fresh flowery hints of lilac and lily.
