COMMUNITY BASED SERVICES

618 individuals and families received in-home therapy, substance use recovery support, or home monitoring.

INDEPENDENT LIVING

79 young adults learned skills for living on their own through financial assistance, job and life skills training.

RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT

74 youth received housing and therapeutic intervention to heal from their pasts of abuse, neglect and trauma.

ADOPTION SERVICES

35 families supported as they adopted a child domestically or internationally.

EMERGENCY SHELTER

20 youth received short-term care as referred by the Depts. of Community Services or Juvenile Justice.

EVOLVE COUNSELING CENTER

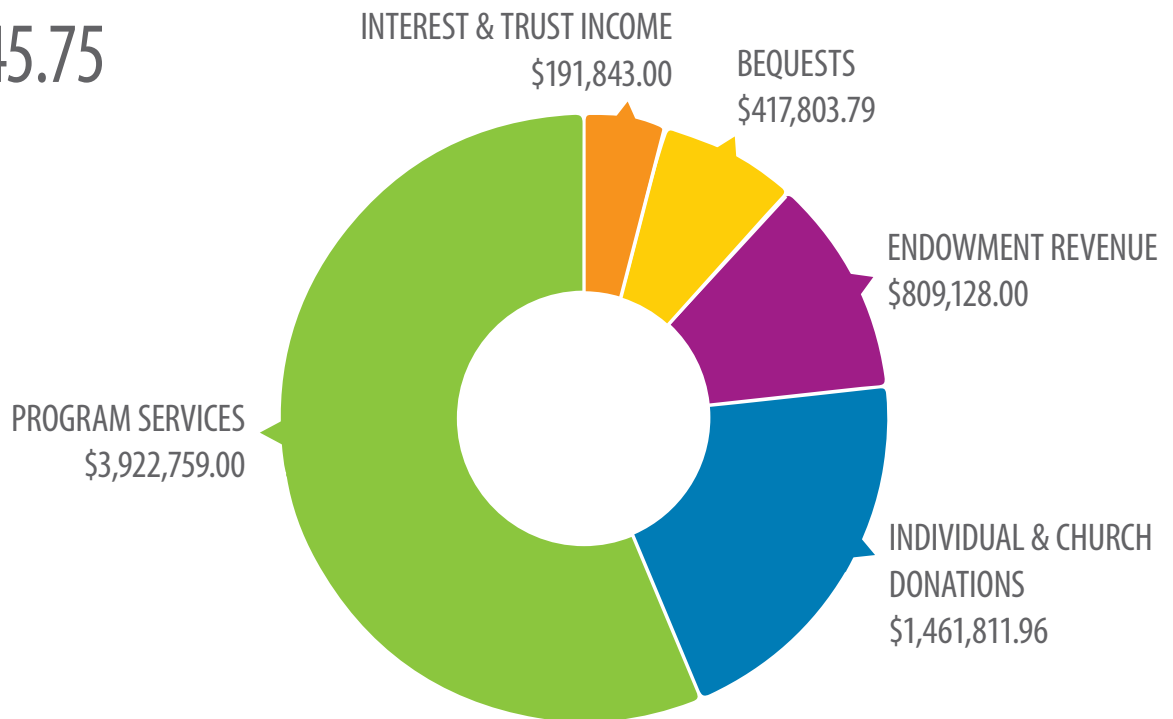
20 individuals met in-office with our therapists to improve their mental and emotional health.
