In Memoriam: Alum Dr. David Miller

Dr. David Miller, an alum of KyUMH and gifted pediatric surgeon of the Orlando community, passed away on Sunday, March 10, 2019 at age 69. He was born August 12, 1949 in Harlan, Ky. At age 9, he was placed at the Versailles campus of KyUMH and stayed until he graduated from Woodford County High School. He always expressed gratitude for the care he received.

After completing his BS degree from Asbury College and his Medical degree from the University of Louisville, Dr. Miller joined the staff of Arnold Palmer Hospital in 1993. He faithfully served the children of Central Florida for the next 26 years, where he performed over 12,000 operations,

often on the sickest and tiniest of children.

He was known for his patience and kind teaching approach, his genuine concern, and his ability to always find time for anyone who needed it.

He found joy and delight spending time with his wife, Barbara, all his children, grandchildren, and dear friends. He was quietly but deeply spiritual and relied on his faith to sustain him through difficult and sad times in his life.

650 Forever Families

Mary Kendall Adoption Program—and its first child placed—turn 30 Years Old

In 1989, the Mary Kendall Adoption Program opened its doors with a vision of bringing children into forever families. In 2019, the program is celebrating thirty years and over 650 successful placements.

Also celebrating thirty years this year is Erin, one of the first children given a home through the Mary Kendall Adoption Program. The Gish family had already completed one adoption with a different agency. Mona and her husband Mike welcomed Andrew, a baby boy from South Korea, into their family in 1988. They were devastated to hear that agency had closed its Louisville office, as they wanted to adopt a sister for Andrew from Korea.

Not long after, they met a staff member of the Mary Kendall Adoption Program, who told them they were accepting five families to

adopt children from Korea. The Gish family was first on the list. "We couldn't believe it!" Mona recalls.

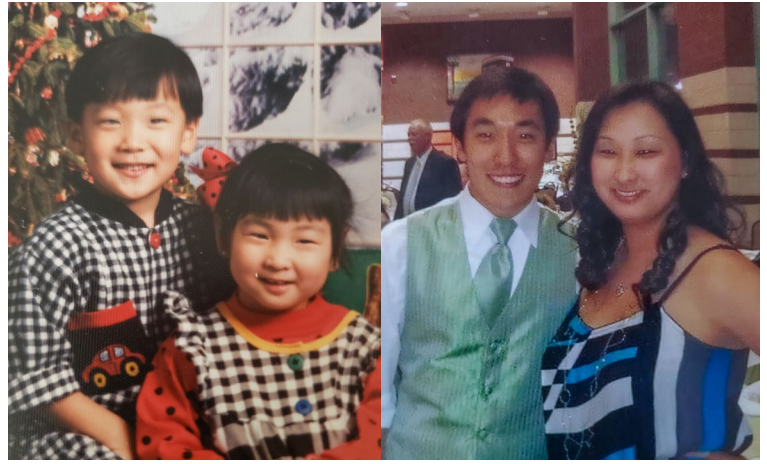
The Mary Kendall Adoption program walked with them every step of the way, from paperwork to home studies to support as they waited for a referral. The Gishes were excited about the prospect of adopting another child.

Feeling the pressure of bringing home a new member of the family, Mona worried about whether Andrew would be jealous of the new baby and whether she could love her new daughter as much as her son... but in December of 1989, all those fears melted away when Erin arrived. "They bonded immediately, no jealousy. It was as if they knew they were supposed to be together," Mona said of her children.

Andrew and Erin grew up embracing the fact that they were adopted. They learned about their home country while discovering appreciation for other cultures through adoption support groups provided

by the Mary Kendall Adoption Program.

Both Andrew and Erin are now exceptional young adults. They were highly involved in sports and excelled academically. Both received full-tuition undergraduate scholarships and have completed master's degrees. Today, Andrew is a design engineer for GE and Erin works as a school psychologist.

Their mother expressed tremendous gratitude to KyUMH. "I will forever be grateful to the Mary Kendall Adoption Program," she said, "I would not have fulfilled

my dream of becoming a mother without them.

Adoption Services Director Jeannie Howard estimates that in her 19 years, she has personally helped bring over 300 children home. "I couldn't ask for a more rewarding job," she says. "I love being able to help bring families together through adoption."

Patricia doesn't remember having friends as a child. After her parents died in a car accident, she and her older brother grew up with their grandmother, who raised them as best as she could, despite debilitating health issues. **Patricia was more of a caretaker than a child.**

She recalls her brother being "mischievous" and too much for their grandmother to handle. So they were both sent to the Versailles campus of the Kentucky United Methodist Children's Homes (KyUMH) when Patricia was eight.

After some time, Patricia and her brother moved to a foster home that received a stipend yet refused their children basic necessities like clothing and shoes. When her foster father resorted to corporal punishment to discipline Patricia's brother for small offenses, her social worker moved them back to their grandmother's care.

Eventually her grandmother's health declined so much that Patricia moved back to

KyUMH. By this time, she was thirteen years old.

At first she was shy and isolated herself. Soon, Patricia transformed. The staff at KyUMH supported her in a way she had never experienced before. **"Anything that I needed, all I had to do was go to the staff and they made sure I got it,"** Patricia says.

She found lifelong friends at KyUMH: "When I was at the Home, I became more outgoing. There were always people I clicked with, so I came out of my shell." **Patricia keeps in contact with her KyUMH friends to this day.**

Besides giving her lifelong friendships, being at KyUMH also taught Patricia important lessons. Currently an active member of her church, Patricia says that "The Home taught me to keep God first and keep reading my Bible." She also learned "big life skills"

through her daily chores and by living with people from diverse backgrounds.

Thanks to the staff at KyUMH, Patricia made good grades and eventually graduated from Woodford County High School.

But just before graduation, Patricia learned her father was actually alive. He had survived the car accident Patricia thought had killed him. She discovered that she had known her father her whole life as a "family friend." Patricia was distraught. She felt betrayed by her own family and became inconsolable.

KyUMH helped Patricia process her emotions and forgive her father. They made it possible

for her to visit and build a relationship with him. **Patricia believes she would have never known him without KyUMH.**

Now, Patricia has a family of her own, holds an Associate's degree in accounting and is currently completing a Bachelor's degree in business management.

She hopes to become manager of a company, and credits her success as a mother and student to KyUMH: "I don't think I would be where I'm at today without the Methodist Children's Homes."

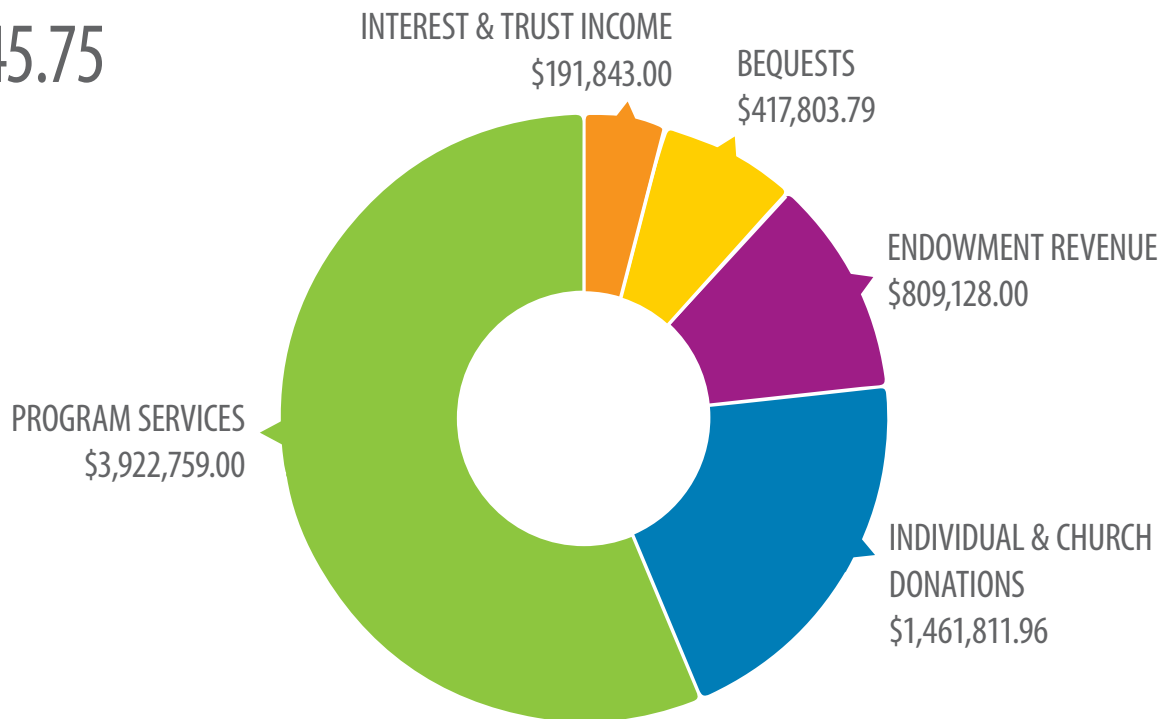

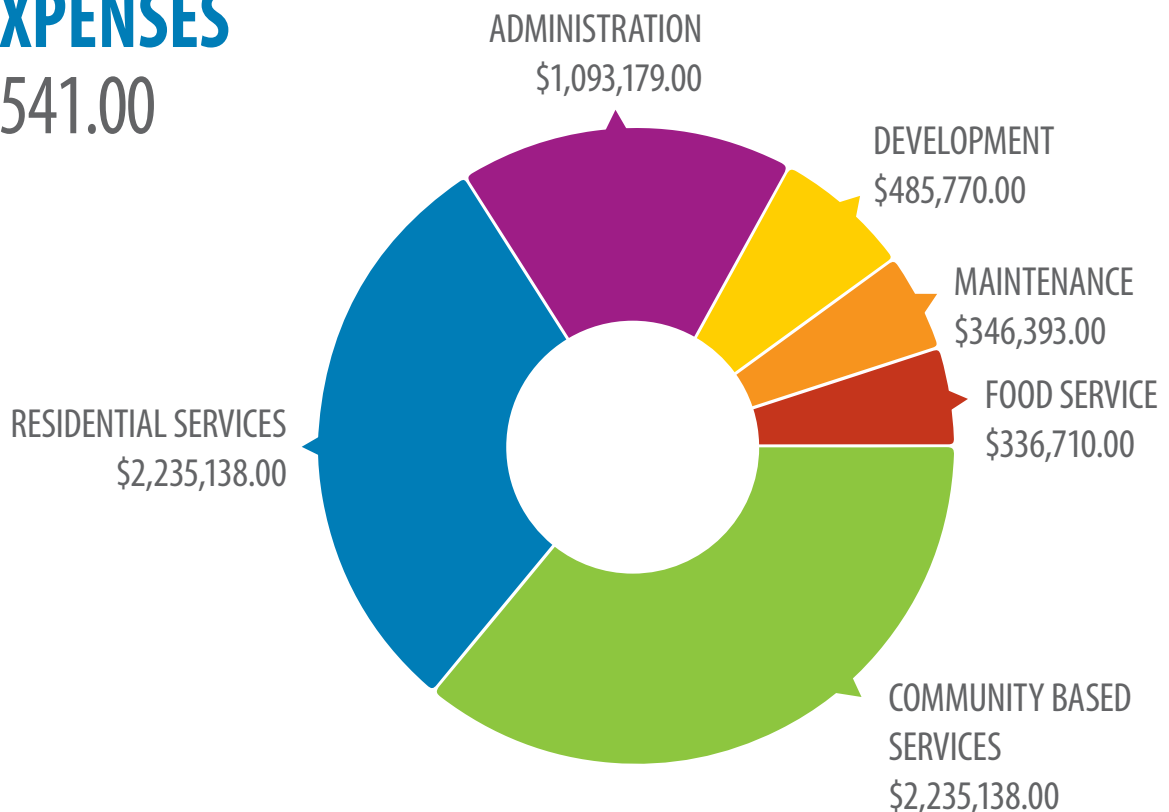
