* For boarding students, a GST charge on food of \$629 is included in the boarding fees

Discounts

A sibling discount is offered to families with more than one child enrolled at Assumption College concurrently. The following discounts apply to tuition fees or combined boarding and tuition fees:

- 2nd child 10%
- 3rd child 25%
- 4th and subsequent children 50%

An early payment discount of 3% is applicable if the total annual tuition fees or combined boarding and tuition fees are paid in full by 23 April 2020.

Fee in Advance Payment

For all day school students, fee in advance payment of \$1,500 must be paid in the term before commencing at Assumption College. For all boarding school students, a fee in advance payment of \$6,300 must be paid in the term before commencing at Assumption College. Fee in advance payment will be required in each year of attendance except in year 12. Fee in advance payment will credit towards the following year's fees.

Special Circumstances

Where special, difficult circumstances exist, parents are invited to discuss these with the Principal or Finance Manager with a view to lessening the financial burden incurred from choosing a Catholic Education.

Additional Charges That May Apply

- Elective subject material charges – There may be additional charges for materials needed for individual projects during the year
- Portable computer annual charge – \$400 annual charge
- Locker fee – one off fee that applies to all new students to the school
- Photocopying/text book fee – may apply in lieu of purchasing textbooks, refer to appropriate booklist
- Lost library book – replacement cost of books not returned at the end of each term (reversed upon book being returned)
- Damage to school/boarding house – applied after parents have been notified
- Instrumental music – applies only to students undertaking this co-curricular activity
- Dance – applies only to students undertaking this co-curricular activity
- Printing and photocopying – an allowance is applied to each student on a monthly basis via their student ID card for this purpose. Additional access to these services will require payment directly to the school administration office
- Electrical tagging fee – charge for testing of each electrical device in the Boarding Houses
- Laptop repair - \$250 fee charged for damage repair

As far as is practicable, the above fees and charges cover the supply of compulsory excursions/incursions/activities and most classroom requirements. Parents are liable to cover the costs of uniforms and booklist items.

Charges relating to non-compulsory activities may be made throughout the year. Charges will be made based on participation in these activities and will not be applied to the school fee account, e.g. Year 12 graduation, French Exchange, various immersions and interschool events. These activities require payment in advance. Payment methods will be given on relevant documentation sent by the College.

Where a student is enrolled in VET/VCAL subjects conducted by an external institution, the College will not pass on a charge.

Families using the bus service provided by Assumption College will be billed separately to school fees.

Please note that a one term fee in lieu of notice will be applied if students leave the College without prior notice.
