Modeling Servant Leadership in the Marketplace

- 1) **As a leader, it's important to establish trust with those you lead by communicating your desire to connect with them.**
 - What are two to three attributes, qualities or experiences God has given you that will help you connect with those you lead?
 - What are two or three reasons why establishing trust with those we lead is a foundational need for a healthy working relationship?

- 2) **Matthew 6:33 outlines an important principle for life—to seek God first in every area (family, business, relationships, etc.).**
 - Take a moment to envision yourself and current circumstances through the filter of Matthew 6:33. In what specific areas of your life do you need to re-establish (or establish) God as *first*? How do you think placing God first in these areas will affect the way you approach each area?

- 3) **We can look to the Bible for leadership instruction, direction, and encouragement because Jesus was the greatest model of servant leadership.**
 - What is one area of your life where you've acted upon the wisdom and instruction of Jesus to be a more effective servant leader? How has following His example impacted your leadership?
 - What are two practical ways in which you can demonstrate servant leadership to those you lead?

- 4) **One of the characteristics of a servant leader is their ability to define and cast vision.**
 - The Bible tells us that without vision, people perish. What is your process of writing and casting vision as a leader? What results have you seen from acting upon this biblical principle?

Take Action Through Prayer!

Take a few minutes to identify one or two areas of your life in which you would like greater perspective, clarity or direction. Ask the Lord to show you His way in these areas through His Word. Consider reading one chapter a day from the book of Proverbs for the next month, and write down what stands out to you. Lastly, think about Mark 10:42-45 each day as a reminder that Jesus, the greatest of all leaders, *served*.
