5. Submit an Authorization for the Release of Records and Medical Release Form.

7. Schedule your assessment appointment with your child's team. (918) 814-1085
8. Receive your KGS New Family Packet.
9. Use the KGS "Fantastic First Day" checklist in the KGS New Family Packet to prepare your child for a wonderful year of pursuing Truth, Beauty and Wisdom at KGS.

Enrollment and Book Fees

Enrollment Fee

- An Enrollment Fee of \$55 is due at time of application submission (cash or check) and is non-refundable.

Book Fee

- A Book and Supplies fee of \$500 is due by July 15, 2019 and is non-refundable.

Family Financial Responsibility

At King's Grove School, we understand that private education is expensive and private education for special needs students is even higher. Thus, we seek to establish a program that eases the financial burden on our families. In lieu of tuition for this first year of King's Grove School, each Student at KGS will be responsible for helping the school receive \$5000/student in donations for the 2019-2020 school year.
